

## Visitor Release/Rules

We want our animals and you to have an awesome experience. Visitors must follow all rules for their safety and the safety of our animals. Animals are not preditible, they can and will bite, kick and step on you, we are not responsible for injury, individuals enter the farm at their own risk. Please note: In the event of theft or animal abuse we will prosecute. We take the care of our property and animals seriously.

1. Individuals are allowed to pet, groom and feed the animals.

Be aware that aminals can and will bite. You may feed, pet and groom animals at your own risk, we are not responsible for an animals actions.

- 2. Do not enter areas that are marked "Authorized Personnel Only"
- 3. Do not chase the animals.
- 4 Do not tease the animals.
- 5. Do not climb on gates or fences.
- 6. Do not enter into the pasture with cattle, horses, llamas and alpacas.
- 7. If participating in hay ride individuals must remain seated at all times, and are riding at their own risk.
- 8. If individuals ride a horse they are doing so at their own risk, adults must walk beside horse to ensure child safety.
- 9. This is a real working farm, we are not responsible for what you may step in, wear OLD shoes.
- 10. Children under 10 must be supervised by guardian at all times.
- 11. DO NOT walk barefooted.
- 12. NO aloholic beverages.
- 13. DO NOT PICK UP PIGLETS. Mother pigs will chase you down and attack you!
- 14. Please DO NOT touch pigs in the museum.
- 15. We often take photos and/or videos of our farm visitors interacting with the animals,


These photos may appear on our website, in published materials and/or on facebook.
