- Highland cattle also have a longer expected lifespan than most other breeds of cattle, up to 20 years.
- Despite their fearsome appearance, you may be surprised to learn that Highland cows are not known to be aggressive to each other.
- The Queen of England has a herd of Highland Cattle and has been said it is the only beef she will eat.
- Highland Cattle make great all around homestead farm animals. They make good milk cows as their milk is high in butterfat.
- They are a hardy breed, having been bred to withstand the conditions in the Scottish Highlands.
- They have an unusual double coat of hair. On the outside is the oily outer hair—the longest of any cattle breed—covering a downy undercoat.
